Monday	Name writing - Parent to write or print out child's name, remembering a capital letter at the beginning of the name and the rest lower case, for the children to look at. Children to practice writing/copying their name, remembering to use the correct pencil grip.	Starting to think about farm animals - Talk about what a farm is and think about what animals might live on a farm. Name the animals and talk about anything you already know about them. Have you been to a farm, or seen any of these animals before?
Tuesday	Listening - If you are able to, play this farm animal sounds game. Listen to each sound and have a guess which animal you can hear. See how many you guess correctly, are there any you were unsure of? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uF74DU34q2 <u>Y</u>	Learning about farm animals - Find out some information about farm animals, from books or online. Think about what they look like, what they eat, what noises they make, where on the farm they live. How would you describe these animals? Which one is your favourite?
Wednesday	Maths - Discuss the 2D shapes that we have talked about in school – think about circles, triangles, squares, rectangles and have a go at drawing them. You could get a grown up to help you with this and to check you have drawn the correct number of sides. When you have drawn the shapes, have a look around your home or if you go out for a walk and look to see which of the shapes you can spot in the environment.	Making a farm animal - Think back to the farm animals you have been thinking about this week. Choose one, maybe one that is your favourite and draw it on a piece of paper, remembering to think about their features – how many legs they have, whether they have a nose or a beak, if they have ears, anything else they have on their body.
Thursday	Pre writing shapes - Below are the prewriting shapes that we practice at school. These are the shapes you should be practicing to help with your drawing. Choose some of the shapes to copy and draw and as a challenge you could see what pictures you can draw using these shapes.	Making a farm animal - Look at your drawing you created yesterday and add colour using any medium. This could using colouring pencils, chalk, paint or collage materials, depending on what materials you have access to at home. Think about what colours your animal would be.

	Remember to think about how you are holding your pencil.

Before your child can learn to write, he or she needs to be able to draw these shapes




