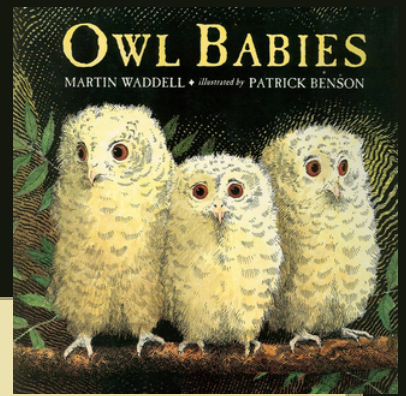

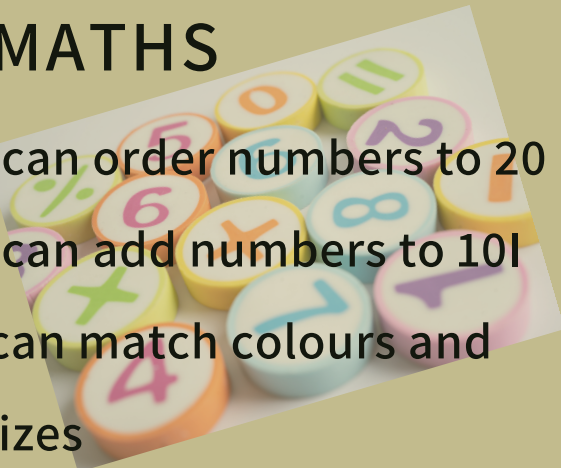

- Keep on trying when things are difficult



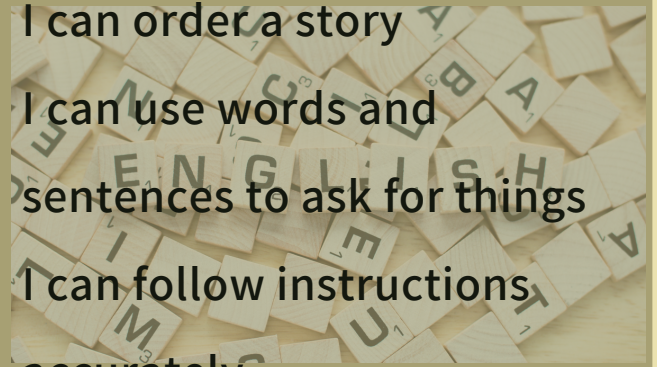
MATHS

COMMUNICATION

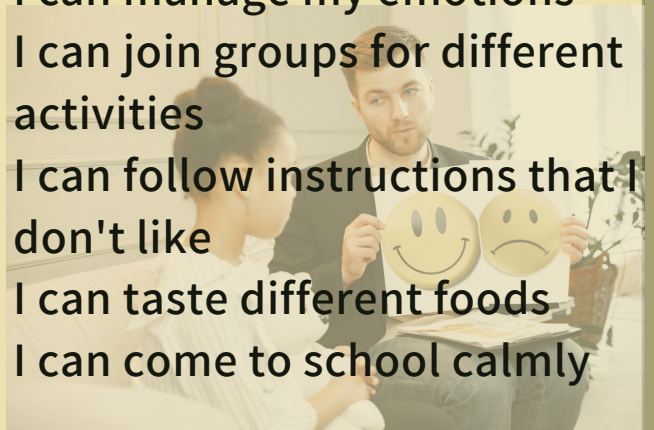
I can ask for things that I need

I can come to school calmly



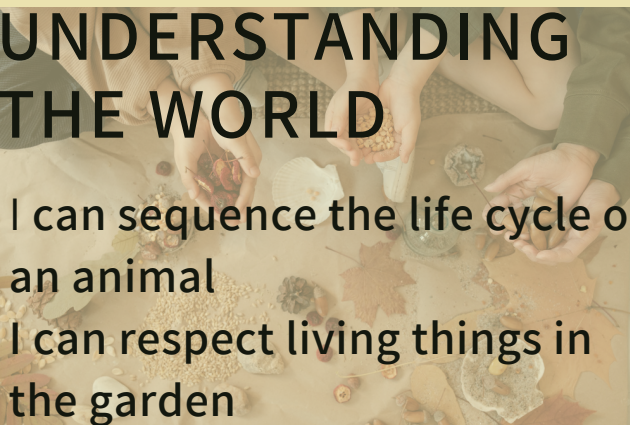
ART

I can use different textures for effect



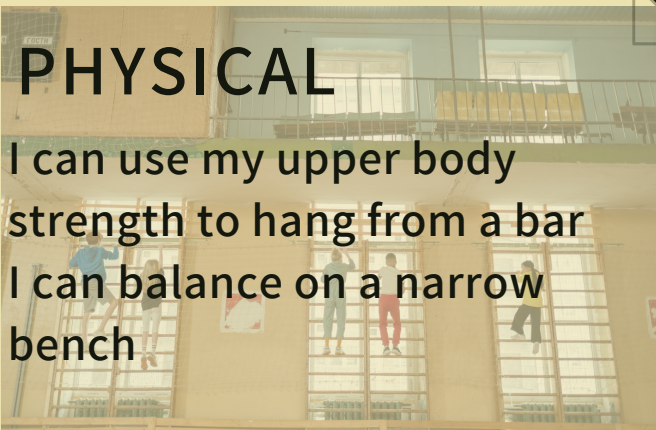
UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD
