

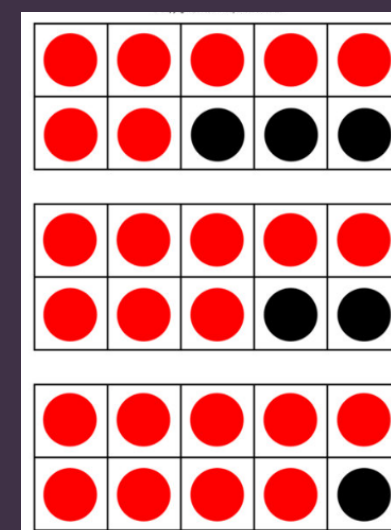

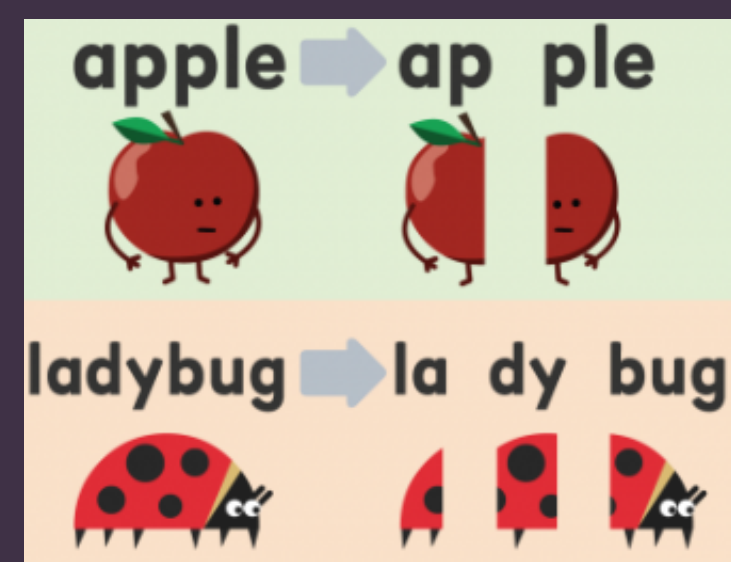
MATHS

I can identify and moderate my own feelings socially and emotionally

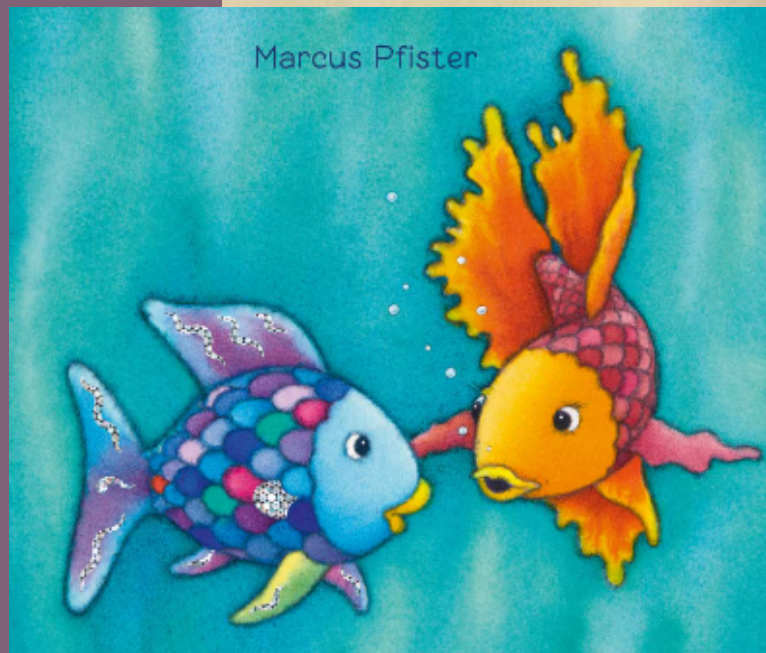


ART
