Pupil Premium

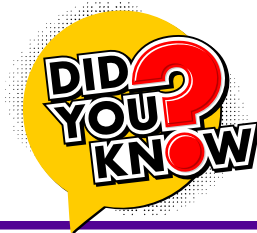
Pupil Premium funding is given to schools by the government to improve educational outcomes for disadvantaged pupils in state-funded schools in England.

Is your child entitled to Pupil Premium funding?

Your child could be entitled to Pupil Premium if you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed below:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Pupil Premium funding is used at New Town to pay for more staff to support pupils with their pastoral needs and to give targeted interventions to help children be successful. We also use some money to subsidise and pay for extra curricular activities, to help broaden horizons.

Pupil Premium children at New Town receive:

- Free school meals for children in Years 3-6
- Free after school activity clubs
- Residential trips costs subsidised by 20%
- Free pupil learning pack with every successful application, including pencil case with stationary, multiplication grid and phonics sound mat.
