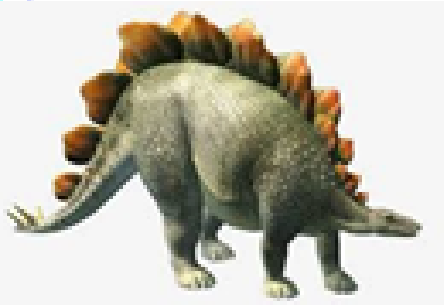

dinosaurs.

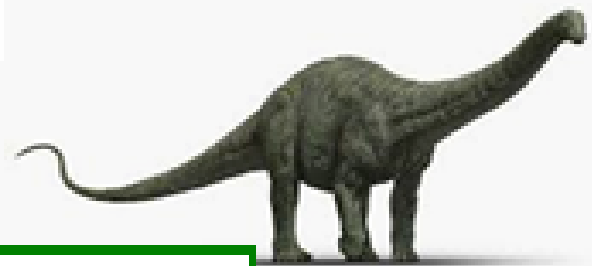

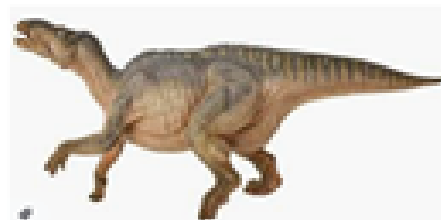
