What do you and your child love about New Town?

Friendly and efficient environment. New Town is good school. It has caring and loving staff to take care of children. My son enjoys the computer club, like the fact that my child is happy at school and is being pushed to the best of her ability. Caring, support my daughter well, she learns a lot. He loves the teachers and pupils. He loves the interaction, play times and study times. Good primary school and lovely teachers. They have a good relationship with teachers and friends. The pastoral support is invaluable. NT provides a safe and enjoyable environment. Happy, safe place for learning. My child feels safe at school. The progress that this school is making is wonderful. Keep it up. I believe the school caters for each child individual needs. And that the extra support is there if the child needs it. Happy environment: my child comes with happiness to school. The environment and how friendly everyone is. Everything. We love that our children are happy and leave confidently to attend the school each morning. That in itself speaks volumes. Also, any problems are dealt with promptly. Both my, now departed, and current year 6 children love NT - even when things get tough, the staff go out of their way to be supportive - from 2 children who hated school and were frightened they now know what a safe, supportive, educational environment is: thank you! That year 3 and 4 are combined, better socialising with other children. Really appreciate work done by teachers. Friendly staff, teachers are available to listen to concerns. He loves each and every thing. He like doing PE, extra clubs and different kinds of subject. Much improved compared to previous year on everything. I love the fact my daughter has made huge progress already in year 6. It's very friendly and welcoming. Listening and supportive to parents and children. Very welcoming: amazing staff. Always willing to talk with parents & cares about children. It's a new school for my son and he really enjoys it: he likes the god idols in his classroom which shows multicultural respect towards religion and beliefs. All three of my children have made good bonds with their class teachers, which keeps my child at ease at school, but also peace of mind for me knowing how shy my children are. NT is open to my child and myself. Teachers are always listening to the parent. Homely environment, lots of activities.

Selection of comments:

What would you like to see improved further at New Town?

Better communication via email or text. The behaviour of other children in the school. Bullying - I think it can be dealt with better and parents informed of outcomes and procedures. A lot of parents need after school club. When the children leave the class there is confusion. Love to see some small workshops and training on how to teach kids at home: I really struggle to grasp the method and technique that my children are learning at school. Playing area: little more space for kids to play. Communication, extra help, classes too big, issues relayed are very slow to get sorted. More education study club and homework. Bigger portion on food plate. Squash instead of water. More fun days. Sports day - I would like to know more about how it is organised/practiced as I feel it can be very difficult for children with additional needs. More shade and seated areas in the playground. More structured play /games at play time. More events for nursery students. More regular contact with parents about child progress. Nothing, it's wonderful. A pyjama day. NT has improved a lot. Just keep on the same track. Communication - occasionally getting info at the last minute. More sports and games opportunities for the kids. Give them a little more homework and keep them busy. General cleanliness. More PE equipment to play in playground.
